Our core curriculum for Reading, English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies follow the California Common Core State Standards. Science, Math & I.T. Coordinator (Middle & High School) Rachen Singhakumar

Welcome to the new academic year! I am Dr. Rachen Singhakumar and I will be teaching Biology (Grade 9), Health Education (Grade 10 - 12) and AP Biology (Grade 11 - 12) in addition to coordinating the Science, Math and I.T. department (SMIT department) this year. This is going to be my 10^{th} year here at TRIS and I am very excited to be seeing some new and returning faces. As a department coordinator, I will be overseeing and working together with the brilliant and highly enthusiastic G6 – 12 Science and Math teachers and schoolwide Computer teachers. My responsibility is to ensure that our students receive great learning experiences are challenged with the most exciting and up to date curriculum, so they are ready to face

the ever-changing world. Science classes here are conducted in accordance with the NGSS curriculum. Our science lab sessions adhere to the core Science classes so students get both theoretical and practical experiences. Math classes follow the Common Core standards and our I.T. classes follow the California standards and the Robotics standards (Mindstorm EV3 - Carnegie Mellon University). We will be continuing to incorporate Robotics as a part of the G4 - 9 Computer classes and Python in the G9 Computer classes. This year, TRIS will be offering a new diploma program called "Computer Science". Students who wish to graduate with this diploma will experience courses like Animation & Graphics, Advanced Programming and learn more about Robotics, Artificial Intelligence and Web development and applications. Four of the five AP classes offered by TRIS are also under our department (Chemistry, Physics II, Biology and Calculus AB). From the past results, I am pleased to mention that a lot of our students perform exceedingly well in the official exams. The SMIT department organizes two big school events which are the Science Fair and the Math Meet. We anticipate including Robotics competition in the future as well. Additionally, our department also offers an after-school club called the Math league. Last year, some of our very keen students have also facilitated their own clubs like Coding, STEM and Engineering. I am sure there will be more of such once we return to school. With that said, I hope to welcome you all back in person very soon.
