### RE: Resumption of On-Campus Learning from Monday 17<sup>th</sup> January, 2022

Dear TRIS Community,

We have been monitoring the Covid situation very carefully and as ever, our first priority is the safety and health of our community. We also understand the importance and benefits of on-campus education and the diminished learning and social-emotional impact online classes has on our students and their families. We have therefore made the decision to **resume on-campus learning from Monday 17<sup>th</sup> January, 2022.**

It is important that we all feel comfortable being back at school and it is for this reason that we along with many other schools are increasing the use and frequency of ATKs. Each Monday and Wednesday before entering school, all students, faculty and staff must take and submit a negative ATK. Students will need to physically present their negative ATK with their name and homeroom class written on it in a plastic bag at the gate upon arrival at school. We ask all members of the TRIS community take an ATK at the first sign of symptoms including sore throat, sneezing, runny nose, sustained headache, fatigue, fever or body aches.

TRIS will continue to follow Covid-Safe practices on campus and report and take advice from the Ministry of Health upon each positive Covid case and take the steps required to ensure everyone's safety.
